CIRCULAR TO CREDITORS

1. We refer to the abovementioned matter, as well as previous correspondences herein.
2. The joint Provisional Liquidators brought an application for the sequestration of the director of Finalmente Global (Pty) Ltd (in liquidation), Mr Jacobus Thomas Van der Merwe (Identity number: 780214 5073 08 8) on the 25th of August 2021 under case number 38611/2021 in the High Court of South Africa Gauteng Division, Pretoria. The provisional order was granted on the 25th ultimo with the rule *nise* return date being the 16th of February 2022. A copy of the stamped Court Order is attached hereto.
3. We further wish to confirm that the statutory First Meeting of Creditors was held before the Presiding Officer, Magistrate: Cullinan. The Master of the High Court has instructed the joint provisional liquidators to inspect each and every claim in terms of Section 45 of the Insolvency Act. Once all the claims have been inspected, we shall revert back to creditors. In the meantime all other creditors are requested to forward their claims to our offices as soon as possible.
4. We further wish to confirm that we are still awaiting on the Master of the High Court: Pretoria to issue the Final Certificate of Appointment herein. Currently the whole Department of Justice's server has been off-line for the last seven weeks. Kindly see the latest media statement received from Department: Justice and Constitutional Development with regards to this matter. Upon receipt of our Final Certificate of Appointment, we shall proceed to convene the statutory

UPDATE ON PROGRESS IN RESTORING JUSTICE SERVICES FOLLOWING RANSOMWARE ATTACK

The Department of Justice and Constitutional Development has made strides in recovering from the ransomware attack that occurred in September 2021.

Over the past few weeks, the team of Departmental officials, industry specialists and advisors from organs of State have successfully contained the spread of the malware. A number of online services have been reactivated in a safe and secure manner. The team has also focused on ensuring that the payment of child maintenance money to beneficiaries is disrupted as little as possible.

Another critical area that has been given high priority is the electronic recording of court proceedings to ensure that courts are able to operate as normal. Most of the recordings are intact, and able to sync back to the central repository. Where courts are still experiencing challenges, a special capacity has been deployed to attend to queries on a case-by-case basis. The web portal that is used by transcribers to download court recordings for transcription purposes was successfully restored.

Furthermore, considerable progress has been made in restoring the Integrated Case Management System (ICMS), which is an administrative system used at all courts, particularly the Office of the Master of the High Court. Parts of the system are already accessible, such as curatorship, and the online portals used for historic

searches. More work will be done in the next few days to complete the process of bringing back online functionality in respect of Trusts, Deceased Estates and Insolvencies (amongst others).

Following finalisation of a high level assessment in respect of the possible leak of personal information, and in line with the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, the Department issued a notice on its website to its data subjects. The Department has strengthened security measures to protect sensitive personal information under its custodianship. Measures include upgrading our ICT security infrastructure and ensuring more stringent access control electronic and physical.

The Department would like to thank members of the public for their patience and understanding during this crisis period.
